Who is it for? Youth between the ages of **11-14 and/or in 6th-8th grade* who are residents of the *Town of Ithaca, Village of Cayuga Heights, Village of Lansing, or Town of Caroline (at no cost to participants).***

What is it? The Learning Web's Volunteer Community Service Program is an opportunity for middle school students to make a difference where they live. This spring, students will be volunteering with food pantries, animal shelters, working outdoors and more. We will be exploring and reflecting on different issue areas affecting our community, from hunger to homelessness to climate change.
