**Who is it for?** Youth between the ages of **11-14 and/or in 6th-8<sup>th</sup> grade\* who are residents of the *Town of Ithaca, Village of Cayuga Heights, Village of Lansing, or Town of Caroline (at no cost to participants).***

**What is it?** The Learning Web's Volunteer Community Service Program is an opportunity for middle school students to make a difference where they live. This spring, students will be volunteering with food pantries, animal shelters, working outdoors and more. Our home base for the program will be Boynton Middle School, and from there the groups will travel to different service sites throughout Tompkins County.
